- Do you have lived in or work experience with a community that has not historically had access to evidence-based resources or childbirth education? (For example, LGBTQ+, Black, Indigenous, Hispanic, or immigrant communities; and/or low-income, single parents, rural/urban location), Please explain.
- Have you participated in trainings that address birth justice, human rights in childbirth, and cultural competence with BIPOC or LGBTQ+ communities? If these topics were not included in your initial professional trainings, how did you go on to educate yourself on these topics?
- What do you see as the mission of Evidence Based Birth®? What do you imagine when you think about the future role of Evidence Based Birth®? How do you hope to be involved in that mission?
